RULES FOR SEMI PULL

- 1) Due to time limits during the Celebration, it may be necessary to limit the number of trucks pulling in each class and to also limit the number of classes that each driver can participate in.
- 2) The pull is governed by the judges, with all decisions final. The judges have the right to accept, reject or disqualify a truck at any time during the pull. Class registration will be on the honor system, with any disputes settled by the judges.
- 3) Should a dispute arise, the judges' ruling will be final. Anyone (driver, helpers, or family members) not displaying sportsmanlike conduct will be asked to leave the grounds permanently.
- 4) Any driver not paying attention to and following the signals of the flagman at the far end of the track during their pull will be disqualified.
- 5) All drivers are required to be in line and ready to hook t the sled. You will be given two minutes from the time the sled is back to the start line to be in place and ready for the sled to be hooked to your truck.
- 6) Refunds will only be made if the truck breaks beyond immediate repair before the class starts to pull.
- 7) No hot rodding anywhere on the grounds. This is an automatic disqualification.
- 8) There will be one person (the driver) in the truck while it is in motion.
- 9) Pull committee reserves the right to change the sled setting after the first puller pulls. Should that puller break down and not be able to return at the new weight setting, he will be given one (1) point less than the shortest pull in that class.
- 10) If any parts other than U joints fall from the truck, it will be disqualified.
- 11) Absolutely no loaded tires or wheels.
- 12) No added weights to the truck and absolutely no jerking of the weight transfer machine.
- 13) Select gear you will pull in No shifting once hooked to sled
- 14) The first puller in each class has the option to return and pull in the third position.
- 15) All pullers must be 18 years of age and must wear seat belts. All trucks must be equipped with a charged fire extinguisher.
- 16) Maxi-brake must be applied while hooking to the boat.
- 17) All trucks must be registered by the deadline time. No exceptions, even if the pulls are running late.
- 18) NO ALCHOLIC BEVERAGES ALLOWED ON THE GROUNDS.
- 19) Each driver must sign a waiver of liability at the time of registration.
- 20) NO dumping of air bags.
